In connection with the 10th Anniversary of Cognitive Science Studies at Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń (Poland) we invite you to participate in the Jubilee Conference. We are announcing Call for Papers concerning the broad subject of research and education in the domain of Cognitive Science. We would like to welcome all wishing to participate in this Call to share their insights about development of these subjects, the long term strategies for cognitive sciences and any attempts at propagating interdisciplinary perspective in contemporary research.

We ask you to fill up the attached participation form. Researchers who would like to present 30-minutes papers (**20-minutes presentation + 10 minutes for discussion**) are asked to send an abstract. **The abstract of your paper should have 400 words (including basic literature, if necessary). Notification will follow after pre reviewing of abstracts.**

The conference will focus on the issue of interdisciplinarity which is especially important in the development of science. Interdisciplinary is especially significant in research on cognition where cooperation between psychologists, neuroscientists, computer scientists, mathematicians, logicians, biologists, philosophers, linguists, experts of AI and Robotics and many other is required. **The aim of our conference is showing the specificity of research in cognitive science.**

Topic of interests:

We are looking for

- research papers presented theoretical studies on different aspects of interdisciplinarity (such as problems of methodology of interdisciplinary research, interdisciplinarity or multidisciplinary of research projects in cognitive science, the problem of unification and integration, and many other related topics) as well as
- presentation of research conducted by interdisciplinary research teams.

We are also looking for proposals on **the model of education in cognitive studies, especially for doctoral studies.**
